We will be:

- exploring how seeds disperse in order to survive.
- investigating animals and their habitats.

- about the designer Vivienne Westwood and designing our own tartan.

Music



We will be:

- learning about pulse, dynamics and rhythm.
- exploring instruments and symbols.
- reading simple musical notation.
- singing traditional songs from London.
- composing different music to represent London.

Maths

We will be learning to:

- count on and back in steps of 1, 2, 3, 5 and 10.
- recite number bonds to 20 and know the related subtraction facts.
- find the value of each digit in a two digit number and partition a number in different ways.
- add, subtract, multiply and divide.
- weigh using grams and kilograms and find lengths using centimetres and metres.
- collect data and represent this information on pictograms, bar charts and bar graphs.



English

We will be learning:

- how to write a news report about The Great Fire of London.
- to write a diary about The Great Fire of London.
- how to write a story based on the story 'Katie in London'.
- to write a riddle, describing a London landmark.

Physical Education

We will be learning to:

- throw, catch and invent our own games.
- create and link movements in Pilates lessons.
- travel in a variety of ways on the floor and on the apparatus.

History

We will be learning:

- about a significant historical event - The Great Fire of London.
- to compare life from the past to the present day.



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Geography
