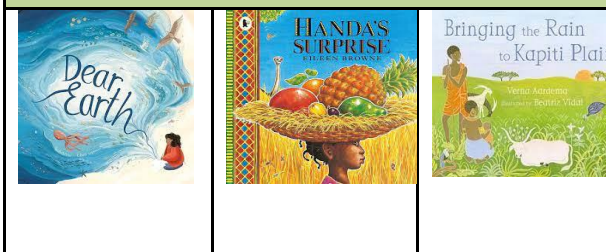

EYFS- who celebrates St David's day and St Patrick's day and how they are celebrated

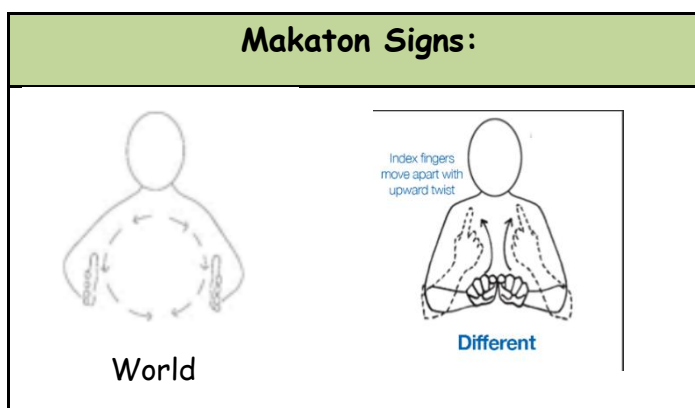
NC- to talk about features of the UK and compare this with Kenya, discussing the similarities and differences between them both- such as climate, wildlife and food.
