

#### Phonics Results Year 1

Mainstream children only - 90 children




Including children from the high needs Communication and Interaction Needs Centre- 95 children




Phonics Results Year 2

Including children from the high needs Communication and Interaction Needs Centre - 89 children








Children assessed as working 'At' achieved Age Related Expectations (ARE.) The term 'Greater Depth' is used to measure a pupil's level of understanding. Achievement is now focussed on the depth of understanding of the areas taught and the ability to apply this understanding in a variety of contexts. Once the children's knowledge is secure within their year group objectives, learning activities are planned to deepen their understanding of the learning in their own year group.

# Percentage of children achieving a Good Level of Development (GLD) at the end of Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS.)

Children are said to have reached a GLD at the end of EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level in:

- The early learning goals in the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development, physical development and communication and language.)
- The early learning goals in the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

These results show that the number of children achieving a GLD in 2023 decreased. There were however, a large number of children with an identified special educational need in this cohort meaning that some did not achieve the early learning goals in some of the prime areas such as communication or physical development, but achieved the goal in the specific areas. The results for children attaining the early learning goals in the specific areas of mathematics and literacy were:
