Fred Talk- oral segmenting and then blending of a word e.g. b-l-e-w blew

Fred in your head-segmenting and blending in your head to then say the word aloud


Fred Fingers- children segment the word to work out how many sounds there are in it and then hold up that number of fingers. Each finger is then pinched as they say the sound

Red Words- words that cannot be sounded out e.g come

Green Words- words that can be broken down into their individual sounds and 'fred talked' e.g. rain

Special Friends- digraph/ trigraph (two letters making one sound)





- Fred Talk to the children some words with that sound in.
- Flashcards-spot the new sound in the pack.
- Read Green words with the sound in.
- Read Green words in with the previously taught sound in.
- ▶ Read alien words with the sound of the day in.
- Spell words with today's sound and previously taught sound.
