

















Emperor Butterflies - Animals Big and Small

Key vocabulary	
Dinosaur 	A group of reptiles that lived a long time ago.
Life Cycle 	A series of stages a living thing goes through during its life.
Frogspawn 	The eggs of a frog, which are surrounded by transparent jelly.
Tadpole 	The larva of a frog or toad that has a long tail, breathes with gills, and lives in water.
Froglet 	A tiny frog that has recently developed from a tadpole.
Frog 	A tailless animal that is an amphibian with smooth moist skin and webbed feet that spends most of its time in water.
Wormery 	A container in which worms are kept.
Earth Worm 	Soft, long-bodied invertebrates, or animals without a backbone.
Eggs 	An oval or rounded body surrounded by a shell or membrane by which some animals reproduce and from which the young hatches out.
Caterpillar 	The wormlike larva of an insect and usually a butterfly or moth.
Chrysalis 	The hardened protective case made by and enclosing a moth or butterfly pupa.
Butterfly 	An insect that has a slender body and large coloured wings covered with tiny overlapping scales and that flies mostly in the daytime.

Learning intentions


We will learn to:
